<i>Grade level</i>	1st grade
<i>Length of lesson/activity</i>	6 hours
<i>Content standards / Curriculum objectives</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>Subjects included:</i> History, Culture History, English• <i>Objects included:</i><ul style="list-style-type: none">- to learn and compare how noble people lived in 17th, 18th, 19th and 20th centuries- learn how to distinguish architecture styles and culture
<i>Brief description</i>	Students take part in the tour of Chateau in Libochovice. They pay attention to the Czech tourist guide. Then they listened to the same info, which is given by their teacher in English, because they shared the activity with non Czech speaking school partners, connected with this project. During the tour they were filling in work sheets in English, prepared by the teacher. After the show they went along chateau park.
