<i>Grade level</i>	1st grade
<i>Length of lesson/activity</i>	7 hours
<i>Content standards / Curriculum objectives</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Subjects included:</i> Geography, Mathematics, IT</li><li>• <i>Objectives:</i><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- to learn how to read in maps and be able to find the way using maps</li><li>- to learn how to work with a mobile phone with a satnav and a mobile application C: Geo and a compass</li><li>- learn how to count distances using a map scale</li></ul></li></ul>
<i>Brief description</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students hike in the landscape and follow the instructions in their worksheets and try to complete the tasks.</li><li>• Both the tasks and the instructions are based on student`s ability to read in maps and use a compass and a GPS and C: Geo application</li></ul>
<i>Tools or materials needed for activity</i>	Maps, worksheets, mobile phones, satnav, a ruler, a compass

<i>Supplements</i>	The worksheet, The map of the area
<i>Feedback</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students enjoyed hiking in the landscape and getting to know new places near their town.</li><li>• Students got familiar with touristic maps and got able to use them to find their way.</li><li>• Students mainly enjoy the idea of geocaching when each cache included new instructions. That enabled them to use mobile phone applications, which was very popular with the students.</li></ul>
